NOTES ON MEMBERSHIP *

NEW MEMBERS

All individuals applying for membership will serve one year in probationary status for the purpose of evaluation by the permanent membership. At the end of the probationary period, a vote will be taken by the membership at the next available business meeting for retention as a Student, Junior, Associate, or Regular member. Adults may elect to become an Associate or Regular Member. Please note that \$25 first time does not apply to previous members.

FULL MEMBERSHIP

Full membership may be requested after a suitable period of time. Full Membership entitles a member to 24 hour access to the club building, vote, and hold office. Members seeking this level of membership must make a request to the Board of Directors for their approval. A one-time fee of \$25 will be assessed of the member seeking approval.

REGULAR MEMBERSHIP

Regular membership entitles a member to vote, and hold office.

ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP

Associate members do not have voting rights or the opportunity to hold club office. All members 18 and older (except Student members), completing their probationary year of membership, will serve their next year of membership as an Associate member.

STUDENT MEMBERSHIP

Student members do not have voting rights or the opportunity to hold club office. All Student members 18 and older, completing their probationary year of membership, will serve their next year of membership as an Associate member or a Student member. Student membership is a special level reserved for members enrolled in college, technical, or trade school.

JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP

Junior membership is limited to youth members ages 12 to 17, and require supervision by a parent or guardian. Junior members do not have voting rights or the opportunity to hold club office.

VOTING PRIVILEGES - Only Regular and Full members have voting privileges.
